

President's Report

Speedcubing New Zealand (2025) Incorporated Annual General Meeting

It has been an exciting and significant year for Speedcubing New Zealand. The highlight was the successful incorporation of **Speedcubing New Zealand (2025) Incorporated** under the Incorporated Societies Act 2022, providing a strong governance foundation to support the continued growth of speedcubing throughout Aotearoa New Zealand. Alongside this, we established a leadership structure, adopted a new constitution, and strengthened our operational capability for the future.

Our competition calendar continued to expand, with **30 official competitions** held across **eight cities and towns**, including nine competitions each in Auckland and Wellington. Across these events we welcomed **436 unique competitors** from **24 countries**, including **350 New Zealand competitors**, generating **1,189 competition registrations** and an impressive **48,485 official solve attempts**. These figures reflect the continued growth of our community and the increasing accessibility of official competitions throughout the country.

The Society now has **16 registered members**, bringing together delegates, organisers, parents and volunteers committed to the governance and development of speedcubing in New Zealand.

As our first year as an incorporated society, I would like to particularly acknowledge our officers for the important governance responsibilities they have undertaken. My sincere thanks go to **Rohan Braganza**, who has served as **Treasurer**, and **Richard Foster**, who has served as **Secretary**. Their professionalism and commitment have been instrumental in establishing a strong administrative and financial foundation for the Society.

A key focus this year has also been building leadership beyond the Committee. I would like to acknowledge our outstanding team leaders:

Looking ahead, we are delighted that Auckland has been awarded the **GAN WCA Oceanic Championship 2026**, to be held from **10–13 December 2026**. This is one of the largest events ever entrusted to New Zealand's speedcubing community and represents international recognition of the growth, capability and professionalism of our organisation. The championship is expected to welcome approximately **300 competitors** and **600 spectators** from across Oceania and beyond, leaving a lasting legacy for speedcubing in New Zealand.

Finally, I would like to thank everyone who has contributed to our success this year. To our Committee, delegates, organisers, volunteers, parents, competitors and supporters—thank you for your commitment, generosity and passion.

I would also like to express my sincere appreciation to **Charlie Van Ooran**, Senior Delegate for Oceania, and **Dallas McNeil**, President of Speedcubing Australia, for their encouragement, guidance and generous support during this formative year for Speedcubing New Zealand. Their willingness to share their experience and champion our development has been invaluable.

I also extend my sincere thanks to the sponsors of the **GAN WCA Oceanic Championship 2026**—the **World Cube Association (WCA)**, **GAN**, and **Jane Street**.
